- Prescription Medications
- Over the Counter Drugs
- Pet Medications
- Controlled Substances

Guidelines:

- Needles and sharps will not be accepted.
- Do NOT bring medications to events before or after the listed times
- Please keep items in their original containers.
- Please do not mix medications in the same container. You may block out personal information on the drug container but please keep the drug name visible.
- Households only. Businesses should call 683-4333 for disposal information.
- Practice safe storage by keeping your medications in a secured location.
- Never share your prescriptions.
