Ordinance 2009-3 Town Officer Compensation Ordinance

The title of this ordinance is the Town of Cooperstown Town Officer Compensation Ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the compensation of Town Board of the Town of Cooperstown under General Code of Ordinances, relating to Chapter 1 Section 1.05 F. Compensation subsections 1, 2 & 3. Amend compensation of Town Clerk of the Town of Cooperstown Section 1.06 D. Compensation subsections 1. Amend compensation of Town Treasurer of the Town of Cooperstown Section 1.07 D. Compensation subsection 1. Amend compensation of Town Constable of the Town of Cooperstown Section 1.08 C.3.

The Town Board of the Town of Cooperstown, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 60.32, Wis. stats. and general authority under its village powers under s. 60.22, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders that this ordinance to amend compensation has been presented for adoption by the town board.

In this ordinance:

- A. Chairman of the Town Board shall be paid \$1,250.00 per year effective April 1, 2009 plus per diems.
- B. Supervisors of the Town Board shall be paid \$900.00 per year effective April 1, 2009 plus per diems.
- C. Per Diem: In addition, if an educational class/workshop, monthly meeting or special purpose meeting, the members present shall be paid a per diem of \$30.00.
- D. Town Clerk shall be paid \$10,000.00 effective April 1, 2009 per year plus per diems.
- E. Town Treasurer shall be paid \$7,500.00 effective April 1, 2009 per year plus per diems.
- F. Town Constable shall be paid \$100.00 effective April 1, 2007 per year plus per diems.

By adoption of this ordinance, the Town Board of the Town of Cooperstown appeals any prior adoption by ordinance or resolution for the compensation of town officers in respect to salary, per diems and qualifying meetings and workshops.

This ordinance shall be effective upon publication or posting by the town clerk as required, pursuant to s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
