- Please do not mix medications in the same container.
- You may block out personal information on the drug container but please keep the drug name visible.

**MERCURY THERMOMETER
EXCHANGE PROGRAM**

As part of the Crime Prevention Day Drug Collection you can also bring in your mercury fever thermometers and receive a complimentary digital thermometer.
