and

WHEREAS, Manitowoc County already has nutrient management plans; and

WHEREAS, the proposed regulations constitute an unfunded mandates that the
County will have to pass along the expense to town residents and all taxpayers of
Manitowoc County; and

WHEREAS, there are rules against pollution of groundwater,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of
Cooperstown that it hereby goes on record as opposing Senate Bill 632.

resolution with the County Clerk.
